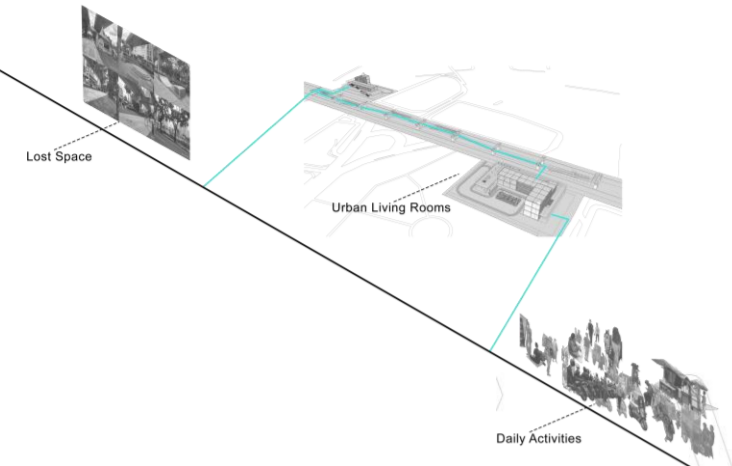
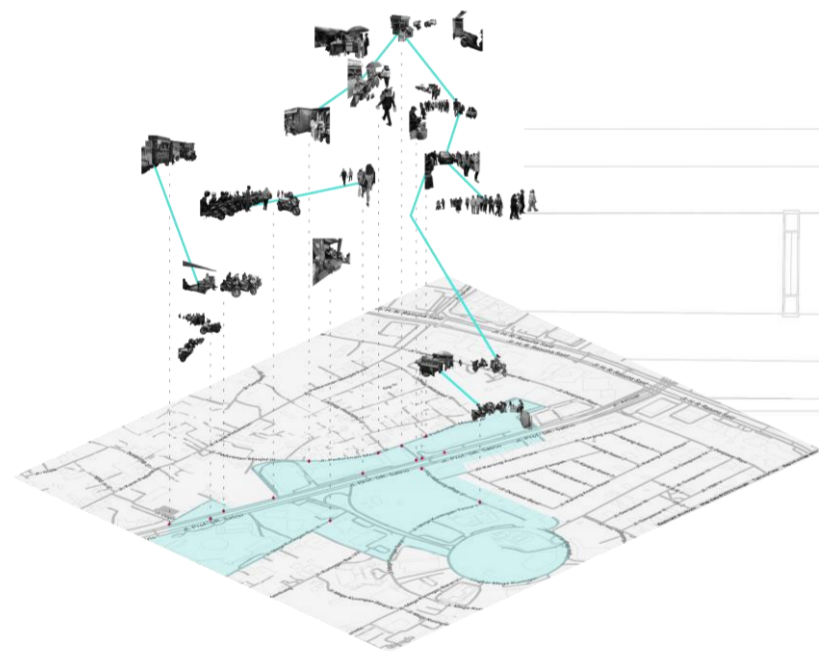

 PROJECT BACKGROUND

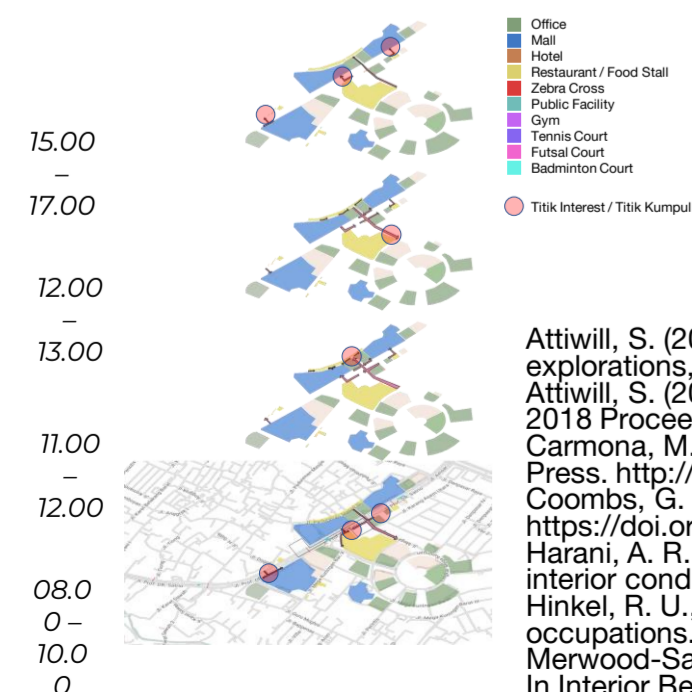

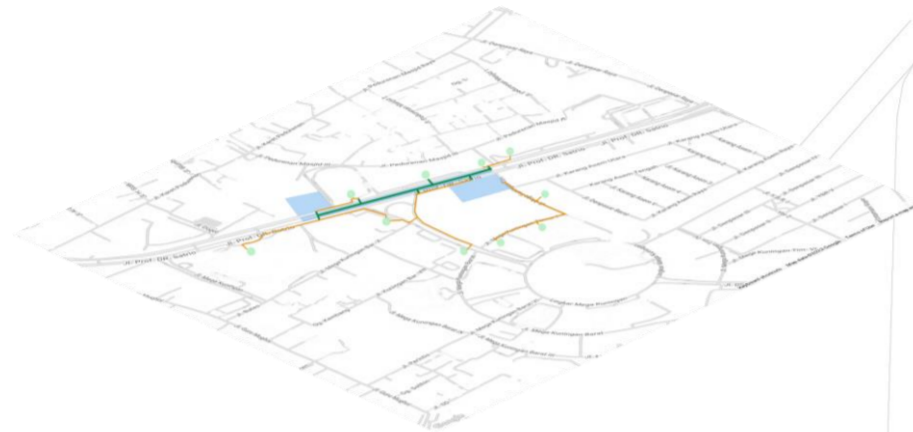

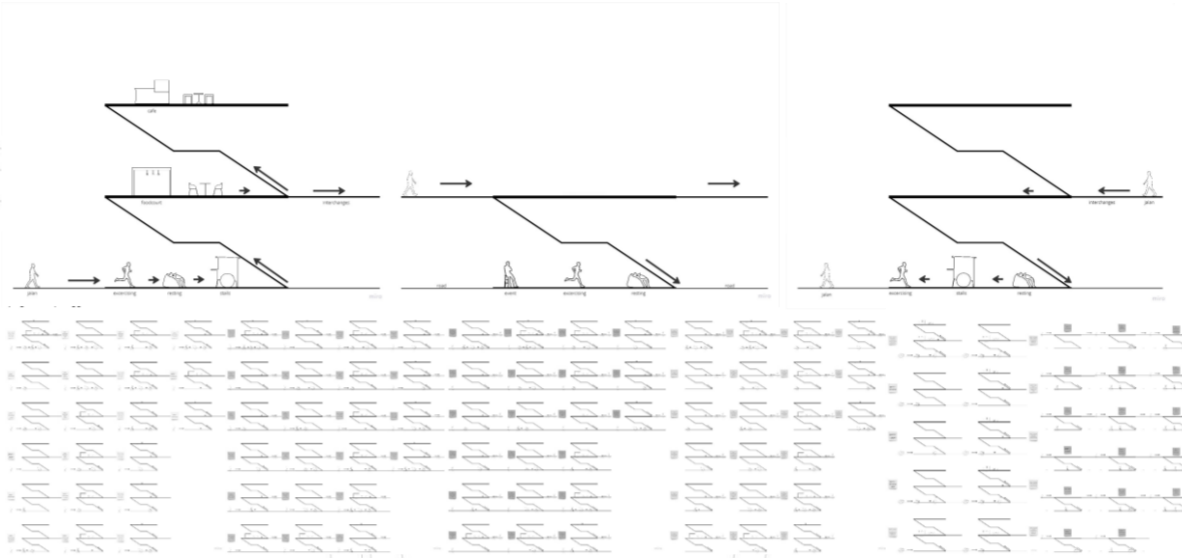
MAPPING- HUMAN MOVEMENT



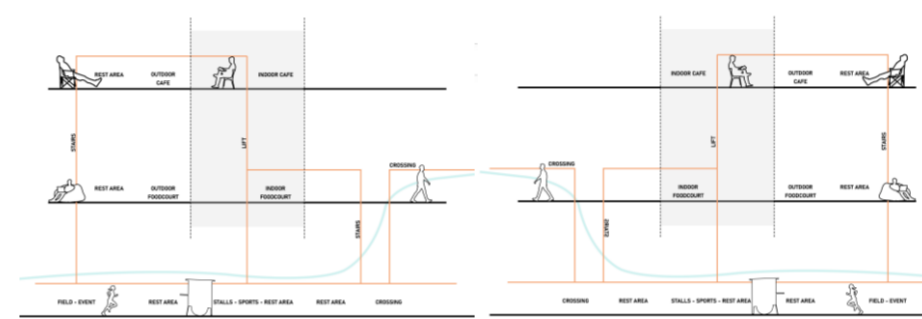

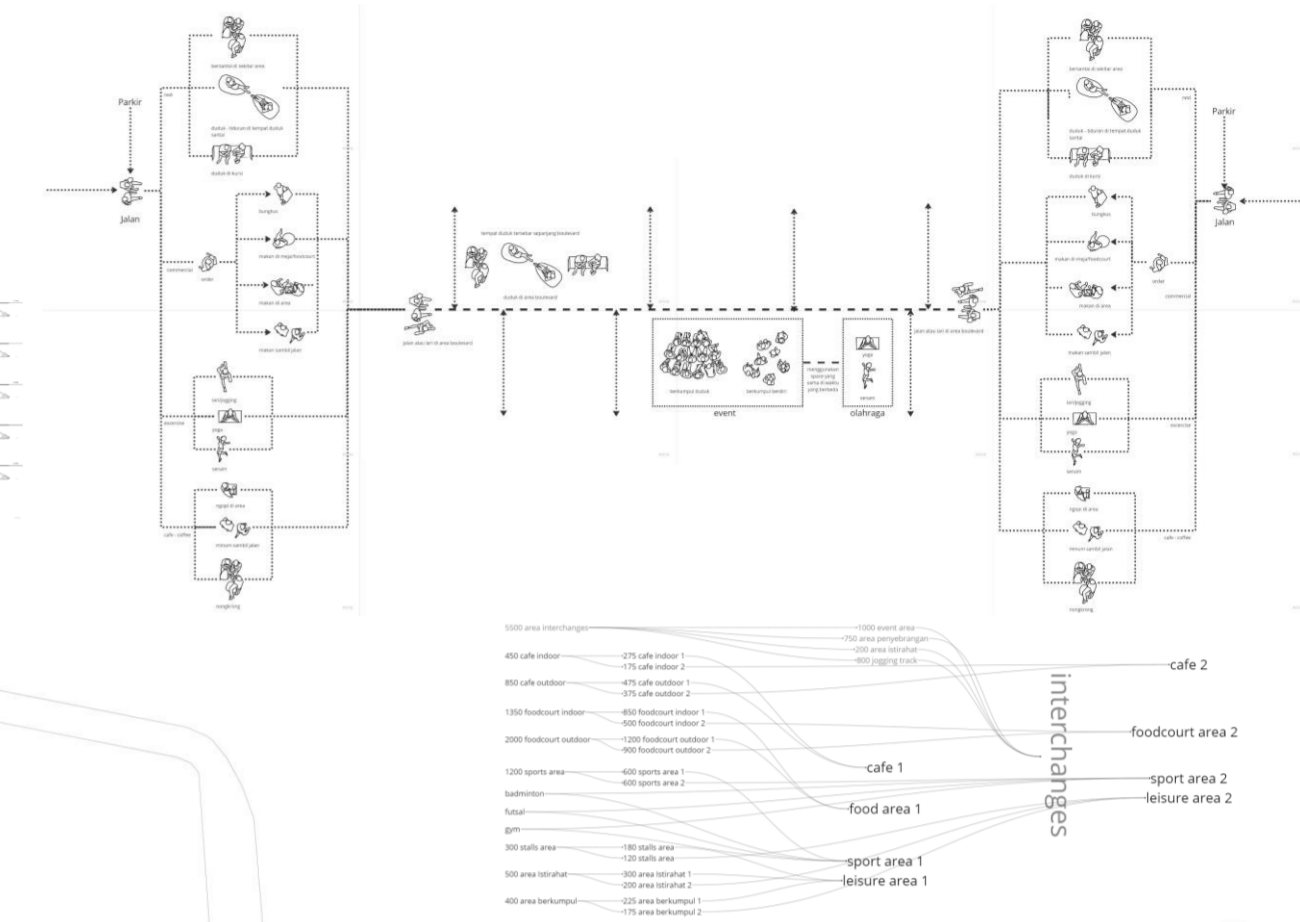
SCENARIO - HUMAN MOVEMENT



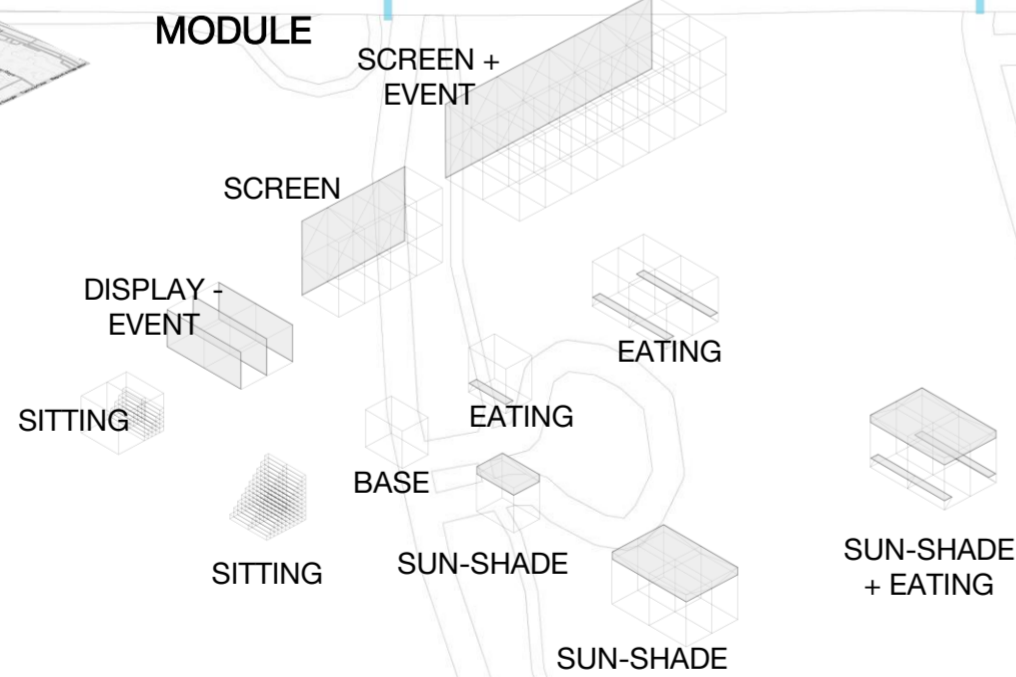
SCENARIO - VERTICAL MOVEMENT
